On February 18, 2020, pursuant to an Application for Temporary Suspension made by the Chair of the District Four Committee on Inquiry, Dazmi H. Castrejon, respondent, was ordered to show cause why this Court should not enter an order temporarily suspending her license to practice law in this State. Respondent filed a response on February 27. Relator filed a response on March 6. Respondent filed a reply to relator's response on March 8.

Upon due consideration, this Court finds that respondent has not shown cause why she should not be temporarily suspended from the practice of law until further order of this Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Dazmi H. Castrejon is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Dazmi H. Castrejon shall forthwith comply with Neb. Ct. R. § 3-316 of the Disciplinary Rules of this Court, and upon her failure to do so, she shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this Court.
