On December 13, 1999, an Application for Temporary Suspension was filed by the Chair of the District Two Committee on Inquiry of the Nebraska State Bar Association, requesting that respondent be suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska. CAUSE HAVING NOT BEEN SHOWN, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Andrei G. Howze is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Andrei G. Howze shall forthwith comply with Neb. Ct. R. of Discipline 16 (rev. 1996), and upon failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Motion of Relator for Judgment on the Pleadings filed on January 19, 2000, be denied as moot.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Nebraska Supreme Court shall cause a copy of this Order of Suspension to be served upon Andrei G. Howze by certified United States mail.
