On November 6, 2002, pursuant to an Application for Temporary Suspension made by the Chair of the District One Committee on Inquiry, Michael L. Cruise was ordered to show cause why this Court should not enter an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in this state. Michael L. Cruise filed a response on November 12, 2002, in which he does not resist entry of an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in the State of Nebraska.

Upon due consideration of the response, this court finds that Michael L. Cruise should be temporarily suspended from the practice of law until further order of this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Michael L. Cruise shall forthwith comply with Rule 16 of the Disciplinary Rules of this court, and upon his failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.
