On May 18, 2005, pursuant to an Application for Temporary Suspension made by the Chair of the District Six Committee on Inquiry, Gregory C. Lauby, Respondent, was ordered to show cause why this Court should not enter an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in this state. Respondent has been served with the order to show cause. Respondent has failed to file a response resisting the entry of an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in the State of Nebraska, and the time period for respondent to file the same has passed.

Upon due consideration, this court finds that Respondent has not shown cause why he should not be temporarily suspended from the practice of law until further order of this court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Gregory C. Lauby is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Gregory C. Lauby shall forthwith comply with Rule 16 of the Disciplinary Rules of this court, and upon his failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.

The Clerk of the Nebraska Supreme Court is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served on Gregory C. Lauby by certified United States mail.
