On July 29, 2014, Relator filed a Motion for Reciprocal Discipline pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. § 3-321. On September 10, 2014, an Order to Show Cause as to why reciprocal discipline should not be imposed was issued directing the parties to respond on or before September 24, 2014. The Counsel for Discipline served Respondent with the Order. Respondent receipted for the Order in July 2015 but did not file a response. On November 12, 2015, Relator advised the Court as follows: "[o]n November 12, 2015, the undersigned confirmed with the United States District Court for the District of Nebraska that the order of discipline in Case No. 8:14-AD-12, is still in effect and respondent is currently suspended from the practice of law in said court."

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent, David W. Tighe, is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of the Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall forthwith comply with Neb. Ct. R. § 3-316, and upon failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.

The Clerk of the Nebraska Supreme Court is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served on Respondent by certified United States mail.
