On August 3, 2016, Relator filed a Motion for Reciprocal Discipline pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. § 3-321. On August 25, an order to Show Cause as to why reciprocal discipline should not be imposed was issued directing the parties to respond on or before September 12. Respondent receipted for the Order on August 27, but did not file a response. On September 9, Relator filed an answer to the Order to Show Cause which "requests this Court impose an order of temporary suspension in Nebraska pending resolution of the disciplinary action against the respondent in Colorado."

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent, Philip M. Kleinsmith, is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of the Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall forthwith comply with Neb. Ct. R. § 3-316 and, upon failure to do so, shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this Court.
