Larry Douglas Sather was admitted to the practice of law in the State of Nebraska on March 12, 1976.

On April 21, 1997, the Colorado Supreme Court issued an opinion suspending Sather for 30 days, said suspension to commence 30 days after the entry of the opinion or May 21, 1997.

On April 30, 1997, the Nebraska State Bar Association filed a motion for reciprocal discipline. On May 29, this court issued an order to show cause why this court should not enter an order suspending Sather from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska for 30 days.

Cause having not been shown, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Sather be suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska for 30 days, effective May 21, 1997.
