ORDER

On June 20, 2012, pursuant to an Application for Temporary Suspension made by the Chair of the District One Committee on Inquiry, Jerre W. Moreland, Respondent, was ordered to show cause why this court should not enter an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in this state. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Jerre W. Moreland shall forthwith comply with Neb. Ct. R. § 3-316, of the Disciplinary Rules of this court, and upon his failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.
