Appeal dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. See Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(1). A document was filed in response to this court's order to show cause requesting a supplemental transcript containing a copy of the decision or order issued by the City of Deshler that Appellant sought to challenge in the district court. That document contains a copy of the Deshler City Council Proceedings dated October 1, 2024. Appellant filed his action in the district court on March 4, 2025. Therefore, the district court correctly found that Appellant's appeal was not timely and the court had no jurisdiction over the matter. See, Main St Properties v. City of Bellevue, 318 Neb. 116, 13 N.W.2d 911 (2024) (board or tribunal exercises judicial function if it decides dispute or adjudicative fact or if statute requires it to act in judicial manner); Meints v. City of Beatrice, 20 Neb. App. 129, 820 N.W.2d 90 (2012) (party seeking judicial review of administrative determination must comply with petition in error prerequisites when review sought is of final order made by tribunal, board, or officer exercising judicial functions; board exercises judicial function when determining property constitutes public nuisance); Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-1931 (Reissue 2016) (petition in error must be brought within 30 days of decision sought to be challenged).
