Motion Appellant for Attorney Fees

Appellant's motion for attorney fees is denied. See Wolter v. Fortuna, 27 Neb. App. 166, 928 N.W.2d 416 (2019) (customarily, attorney fees and costs are awarded only to prevailing party or assessed against those who file frivolous suits). Although Appellant was successful on Appellee's non-compliant cross-appeal, she was primarily unsuccessful on her appeal.

ROD Mot. of Appellee for Summary Affirmance

Appellee's motion for summary affirmance granted. See Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(B)(2). Sentence imposed did not constitute an abuse of discretion. See State v. Jones, 318 Neb. 840, 19 N.W.3d 499 (2025) (absent abuse of discretion by trial court, appellate court will not disturb sentence imposed within statutory limits). A sentencing court is not required to articulate on the record that it considered each sentencing factor, nor is it required to make specific findings as to the facts that bear on each of those factors. See State v. Blaha, 303 Neb. 415, 929 N.W.2d 494 (2019).
