If appellant fails to timely make the required deposit of the estimated cost of preparation, the clerk of the trial court shall transmit a notice thereof to the Clerk and to the court reporting personnel responsible for making the record. Thereafter, unless leave of the appellate court for an extension of time to make the deposit is granted for good cause shown, the appeal shall proceed as if no bill of exceptions had been requested.

Appellant, having failed to request, and receive, leave of this appellate court for an extension of time to make the deposit for good cause shown, is hereby ordered to show cause, within 7 days of the date of this order, why the appeal should not proceed as if no bill of exceptions had been requested.
