Appeal dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. See Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(1). The district court's order of January 28, 2026, granted the defendant's motion for summary judgment and denied the plaintiff's partial motion for summary judgment, including all other claims and defenses. However, the court did not plainly dismiss the complaint filed by the plaintiff. According to the Nebraska Supreme Court, "a final, appealable judgment is one that disposes of the case by dismissing it either before hearing is had upon the merits or after trial by rendition of judgment for the plaintiff or defendant... Only by plainly granting or denying all of the relief sought in the action does the order conclude all the rights of the parties so that further proceedings cannot affect them."
