appellee (related to child support). In the order related to child support, appellant was found in contempt, however, a separate hearing to determine a sanction and purge order was scheduled for March 2, 2026. Where a court makes findings of contempt but imposes no sanction there is no final order from which to appeal. See, Meisinger v. Meisinger, 230 Neb. 37, 429 N.W.2d 721 (1988); In re Interest of Karlie D. 19 Neb. App. 135, 809 N.W.2d 510 (2011). Therefore, we have no jurisdiction over the portion of the January 26th order and appellant's appeal as to appellee's contempt action against him related to child support is dismissed. See, Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(1).

As to the appeal related to the appellant's contempt action against appellee for her denial of his parenting time, we have jurisdiction. Generally, an order denying a finding of contempt of court is appealable. See, Hawks v. Hawks, 32 Neb. App. 70, 993 N.W.2d 688 (2023); Krejci v. Krejci, 304 Neb. 302, 934 N.W.2d 179 (2019). However, appellant shall within 10 days of this order have a supplemental transcript filed with this court containing the parties' August 2024 marriage dissolution decree and any modification thereof, if any, and the appellant's application for an order to show cause filed in July 2025.
