By order of the Court re Dismissal

On the Court's own motion, the appeal is dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. The order entered by the Lancaster County Small Claims Court dismissing the Appellant's claim did not determine the merits of the action. See, Neb. Ct. R. App. P. 2-107(A)(1); Neb. Rev. Stat. 25-1902(1)(a) (Cum. Supp. 2024) (final order must determine the action). Where a lower court lacks subject matter jurisdiction to adjudicate the merits of a claim, issue, or question, an appellate court also lacks the power to determine the merits of the claim, issue, or question presented to the lower court. See In re Estate of Weeder, 318 Neb. 393, 16 N.W.3d 137 (2025). The cause is remanded to the district court with instructions to dismiss the appeal from the small claims court and remand to the small claims court for a decision on the merits.
