To the extent Appellant wishes to waive his right to appointed counsel, a record must be made in the district court establishing that Appellant was informed of his right to appointment of counsel and that Appellant knowingly, voluntarily, and intelligently waived such right and requests to proceed pro se on appeal. Attorney Lembrick is directed to facilitate creating such a record in the district court and to have all relevant motions, orders, and exhibits (if any) properly filed in this court as a supplemental transcript, and/or, if applicable, a supplemental bill of exceptions. Until further order of this court, attorney Lembrick shall continue as Appellant's counsel on appeal.
