Appellant Chad May is ordered to show cause why his trial counsel, the Adams County Public Defenders Office, should not be deemed co-counsel with Remington S. Slama on appeal in case No. A-26-103 and case No. A-26-104. Haoxuan Li, Deputy Adams County Public Defender, filed May's notices of appeal on February 12, 2026. The record before this court in case No. A-26-103 indicates that on February 12, 2026, attorney Li filed a motion for the Adams County Public Defenders Office to withdraw as counsel in the district court, but the record before this court in case No. A-26-104 does not contain a similar motion to withdraw. The record before this court in both cases indicates that on March 4, 2026, attorney Li filed a motion to have counsel appointed to represent May on appeal. In its order entered on March 4, the district court appointed attorney Slama to represent May in his appeals in both cases, but the order was silent as to whether the Adams County Public Defenders Office was allowed to withdraw as counsel. Additionally, the record before this court does not indicate that



attorney Li or the Adams County Public Defenders Office has requested to withdraw as counsel in this court. See *State v. Parnell*, 294 Neb. 551, 883 N.W.2d 652 (2016) (if new counsel has been appointed for an appeal but the former counsel has not withdrawn before an appeal is perfected, the former counsel must promptly withdraw in the appellate court).

Accordingly, attorney Li and the Adams County Public Defenders Office shall be deemed co-counsel with attorney Slama unless within 10 days of this order a motion to withdraw is filed in this court by attorney Li and the Adams County Public Defenders Office and a supplemental transcript is filed containing an order(s) entered by the district court granting attorney Li and the Adams County Public Defender's Office permission to withdrawal as counsel for appellant. The Clerk of the Supreme Court/Court of Appeals is directed to serve a copy of this order on the appellant and the attorneys of record, including attorney Li.
