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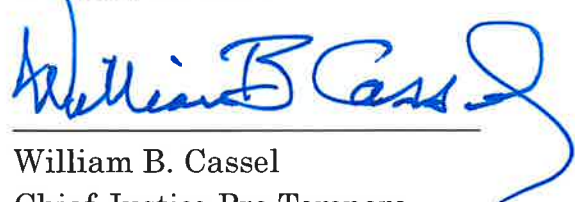
ORDER

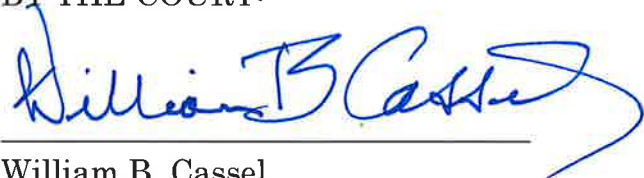


IT IS ORDERED, that Relator's Emergency Application for Leave to Commence an Original Action is granted.

This matter came on for consideration on the 28th day of August, 2026, upon the Emergency Application for Leave to Commence an Original Action and Verified Petition filed by Relator Michael Hilgers, in his official capacity as Attorney General for the State of Nebraska.



Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Respondents shall forthwith submit and certify the “Term Limits for Members of the City Council” Petition, the “Increase Participation in City Elections by Holding City Elections in Conjunction with Statewide Elections” Petition, and the “Allow all Citizens who are Residents of an Area Governed by the City of Lincoln to Vote in its Elections” Petition to the Lancaster County Election Commissioner for certification for the November 3, 2026, General Election Ballot, or show cause by Answer to this Court on or before 9:00 p.m. on Monday, August 31, 2026, why a peremptory writ commanding Respondents to do so should not issue, and then and there return this writ.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if a voluntary appearance has not been entered by Respondents, Relator is directed to accomplish service of this Alternative Writ, Verified Petition, and any operative supplemental petitions on Respondents as provided by statute.
