ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The Appellant, Alejandro J. Guerrero, appealed from the order of the Lancaster County District Court modifying the parties' dissolution decree. The brief for appellant was not timely filed, and a default notice was issued. Appellant filed a motion to extend his brief date which was granted extending Appellant's brief date to September 8, 2026. Appellant did not file the brief for appellant until September 15.

Pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-1110 provides, in pertinent part:

(A) Appellant in Default - Failure to File a Brief. If appellant fails to file its brief within the time allowed and no extension of brief date has been granted, the Clerk shall provide notice to all self-represented litigants and all attorneys of record that appellant is in default for failure to file a brief and is required to file a brief within 10 days after receipt of such notice. Appellant's failure to file a brief within the 10-day period subjects the appeal to dismissal. If appellant has sought and obtained an extension of brief date and the court's order granting the extension subjects the appeal to dismissal without further notice, failure to file the brief within the extended time allowed may result in dismissal of the appeal without further notice. Under no circumstances shall more than one notice of default be required.

The appellant, having failed to timely file the brief for appellant after the issuance of a default notice and after being granted leave to extend the brief date to September 8, 2026, is now ordered to show cause

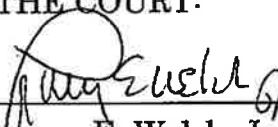


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within 7 days why his appeal should not be dismissed for failure to follow court rules.

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

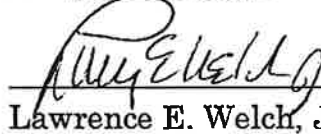
On August 26, 2026, Appellant filed a notice of appeal regarding his convictions and sentences. Appellant timely filed his request for bill of exceptions. However, on September 3, Appellant filed an amended request for the preparation of the bill of exceptions which requested an additional date not included in his original request.

Pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-105(B)(2)(f), late requests for the preparation of the bill of exceptions may not be filed "without leave of the appellate court for good cause shown, which cause shall not be within a party's reasonable control." Appellant has not requested leave of this court to file a late amended request for a bill of exceptions and has not alleged good cause for his failure to timely file the amended request for the bill of exceptions.

Appellant, having failed to request, and receive, leave of this court to file an untimely amended request for a bill of exceptions is ordered to show cause, within 7 days of this order, why the appeal should not proceed as if no amended request for a bill of exceptions had been requested.

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

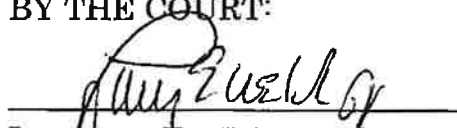
On September 4, 2026, Appellant filed a notice of appeal regarding his convictions and sentences. Appellant timely filed his request for bill of exceptions. However, on September 9, Appellant filed an untimely supplemental praecipe for the bill of exceptions

Pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-105(B)(2)(f), late requests for the preparation of the bill of exceptions may not be filed “without leave of the appellate court for good cause shown, which cause shall not be within a party’s reasonable control.” Appellant has not requested leave of this court to file a late supplemental praecipe for a bill of exceptions and has not alleged good cause for his failure to timely file the amended request for the bill of exceptions.

Appellant, having failed to request, and receive, leave of this court to file an untimely amended request for a bill of exceptions is ordered to show cause, within 7 days of this order, why the appeal should not proceed as if no supplemental praecipe for a bill of exceptions had been requested.
