Appeal dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. See Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(1). The appeal in this case is from orders that are temporary in duration or that compel a mental exam. An order compelling a mental examination is not typically a final order. See, *Steven S. v. Mary S.*, 277 Neb. 124, 760 N.W.2d 28 (2009); *In re Guardianship of Sophia M.*, 271 Neb. 133, 710 N.W.2d 312 (2006). The other orders are of temporary duration or otherwise do not affect a substantial right. See Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-1902 (Cum. Supp. 2024).
