Where, as here, the court has neither rendered a judgment, certified a final judgment under § 25-1315, nor entered a final order, appellate jurisdiction cannot be created merely by voluntarily dismissing unresolved claims without prejudice. *Elbert v. Keating, O'Gara*, 319 Neb. 390, 400, 22 N.W.3d 671, 678-79 (2025). See also *WRK v. Wiegert*, 320 Neb. 822, 30 N.W.3d 832 (2026). Only after the district court has rendered a judgment, certified a final judgment under § 25-1315, or entered a final order, can Appellants file a timely notice of appeal in this case.

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

This matter is before us for purposes of a jurisdictional review. Dawn W., mother of the juveniles in this case, appeals from the order entered by the separate juvenile court of Douglas County entered on February 19, 2026, terminating her parental rights.

The poverty affidavit filed by the appellant purports to be signed by a notary but does not contain an acknowledgment, or jurat, by the notary confirming that the affiant appeared before the notary, attested to the truth of her statements, and signed the affidavit. See, e.g., *In re Interest of Fedalina G.*, 272 Neb. 314, 721 N.W.2d 638 (2006).

The appellant has 15 days to provide this court with an affidavit of the notary confirming that the affiant appeared before the notary, attested to the truth of her statements, and signed the affidavit.

This matter is also before us for purposes of a possible summary affirmance pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(2). The notice of appeal has not been signed by the Appellant.

If a notice of appeal filed in a case involving termination of parental rights is not signed by the parent whose parental rights were terminated, the appeal shall be subject to summary affirmance pursuant to § 2-107(A) unless, following issuance of an order to show cause and a 15-day response time, the before-mentioned parent files an affidavit with the appellate court stating his or her intention to proceed with the appeal or other good cause is shown. Neb. Ct. R. of App. Prac. § 2-101(B)(1)(b).

Appellant is further ordered to show cause, within 15 days of the date of this order, by filing an affidavit with this court stating her intention to proceed with the appeal or otherwise show good cause as required in § 2-101(B)(1)(b).

Failure to respond to this Order could be cause for the appeal to be summarily dismissed pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(1) or to be summarily affirmed pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(2).


