Appellee's motion for summary affirmance is sustained; district court's August 19, 2025, order denying Appellant's petition for writ of habeas corpus is affirmed. The same issue raised in this appeal was addressed in Appellant's appeal at A-25-458, where we concluded that Appellant was charged, convicted, and sentenced as to count three (use of weapon) in accordance with the amended version of the applicable statute that was in effect prior to the date of Appellant's underlying offense. The district court had personal and subject matter jurisdiction over Appellant's 2011 conviction and sentence, and there was a legal basis for its judgment. See Sanders v. Frakes, 295 Neb. 374, 888 N.W.2d 514 (2016) (habeas corpus is a collateral attack on judgment of conviction, and only a void, not voidable, judgment may be collaterally attacked; a judgment is void if court rendering it lacked personal or subject matter jurisdiction or otherwise lacked legal basis for judgment).
