ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

This matter is before us for purposes of a possible summary affirmance pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(2). James G., father of the juvenile in this case, appeals from the order of the Separate Juvenile Court of Sarpy County terminating his parental rights entered on April 8, 2026. James properly perfected his appeal but did not personally sign the notice of appeal. Neb. Ct. R. of App. Prac. § 2-101(B)(1)(b) states:

If a notice of appeal filed in a case involving termination of parental rights is not signed by the parent whose parental rights were terminated, the appeal shall be subject to summary affirmance pursuant to § 2-107(A) unless, following issuance of an order to show cause and a 15-day response time, the before-mentioned parent files an affidavit with the appellate




court stating his or her intention to proceed with the appeal or other good cause is shown.

Therefore, James is hereby ordered to show cause, within 15 days of the date of this order, by filing an affidavit with this court stating his intention to proceed with the appeal or otherwise show good cause as required in § 2-101(B)(1)(b). Failure to respond could be cause for the April 8, 2026, order to be summarily affirmed pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(2).
