ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

This matter is before us for purposes of jurisdictional review. The appellant’s notice of appeal states that he is challenging the order of the Douglas County Court entered on April 14, 2026. The transcript before this court indicates that on that date, the court dismissed without prejudice appellant’s “motions(s)”. However, there is no indication in the record before this court as to the nature of those motions. Without a copy of the motion(s), this court cannot determine whether the appeal has been filed from a final, appealable order. See Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-1902 (Cum. Supp. 2024).

Appellant has 10 days to provide this court with a supplemental transcript containing a copy of any motions relevant to his appeal. Failure to respond shall be cause for this appeal to be summarily dismissed pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(1).
