Elhabbal v. Elhabbal

Motion for Summary Dismissal/Affirmance

Appellee's motion for summary affirmance/dismissal is denied. Denial of in forma pauperis status without a hearing under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-2301.02(1) (Reissue 2016) is proper on the grounds that the applicant is asserting legal positions in the underlying action which are frivolous or malicious. See, e.g., Mumin v. Frakes, 298 Neb. 381, 904 N.W.2d 667 (2017) (looking to habeas petition to determine frivolity); Castonguay v. Retelsdorf, 291 Neb. 220, 865 N.W.2d 91 (2015) (looking to underlying complaint to determine frivolity).
