ROD Misc Submission to Court re Jurisdiction

Appeal dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. See Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(1). Appellate jurisdiction cannot be created merely by voluntarily dismissing unresolved claims without prejudice. Elbert v. Keating, O'Gara, Nedved & Peter, 319 Neb. 390, 22 N.W.3d 671 (2025). And because an order nunc pro tunc merely makes the record reflect what the court actually decided in the original order or judgment and does not make any substantive or material change to the order or judgment, the order relates back to the date of the original order or judgment. In re Interest of Luz P. et al., 295 Neb. 814, 891 N.W.2d 651 (2017).
