Appellant's motion to supplement the record is overruled. Appellant seeks to supplement the record with documents that do not appear to have been provided to the district court either as evidence received at a hearing or by inclusion in the presentence investigation report (PSR). Appellant asserts that certain lab reports "are normally included" in the PSR, however he does not claim that such reports were included in the PSR reviewed by the district court and that they were erroneously excluded in the PSR submitted to this court on appeal. Neb. Rev. Stat. § 29-2261 (Supp. 2025) does not mandate the automatic

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inclusion of such documents in a PSR, and no objection was made to the PSR at the sentencing hearing. See *State v. Moyer*, 271 Neb. 776, 715 N.W.2d 565 (2006) (failure to object to presentence report precludes defendant from challenging it on appeal). Further, if the lab reports had been offered and received at a hearing prior to sentencing and were erroneously omitted from the bill of exceptions, there is a procedure for correcting such an omission. See Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-105(G) (parties may amend bill of exceptions by written agreement at any time prior to time case is submitted to appellate court; if such amendment is not agreed to by parties, matter shall be heard and decided by trial court after such notice as trial court shall direct).
