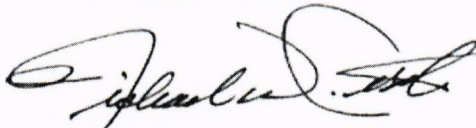
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

This matter is before us for purposes of jurisdictional review. Appellant timely filed a notice of appeal from the sentencing order entered July 14, 2026. However, his “Financial Affidavit,” filed in lieu of the statutory docket fee, has not been properly signed nor notarized.

A proper poverty affidavit serves as a substitute for the docket fee otherwise required upon appeal. See generally Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-2301.01 et seq. (Reissue 2016). The “affidavit” described in § 25-2301.01 requires the hallmarks of an affidavit such as the signature of the affiant and a certificate of an authorized officer. *State v. Haase*, 247 Neb. 817, 530 N.W.2d 617 (1995). Appellant has until August 13, 2026, to perfect his appeal by filing a proper poverty affidavit, to include appellant’s full name and signature, or paying a docket fee. See Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-1912(1) (Cum. Supp. 2024). Failure to respond shall be cause for this appeal to be summarily dismissed after August 13 pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-107(A)(1).
