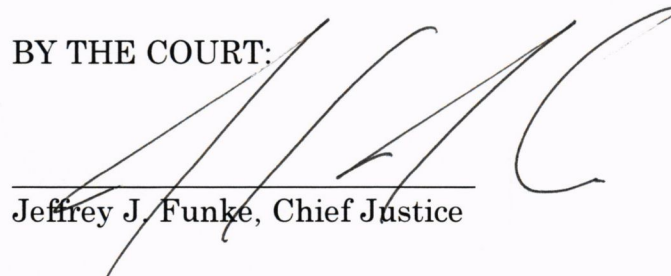
On August 3, 2026, Joshua A. Meyers timely appealed from the Lancaster County District Court's sentencing order. However, appellant did not file a request for the preparation of the bill of exceptions until August 5, 2026.

Pursuant to Neb. Ct. R. App. P. § 2-105(B)(2)(f), late requests for the preparation of the bill of exceptions may not be filed "without leave of the appellate court for good cause shown, which cause shall not be within a party's reasonable control." Appellant has not requested leave of this court to file a late request for the preparation of the bill of exceptions and has not alleged good cause for their failure to timely request preparation of the bill of exceptions.

Appellant, having failed to request, and receive, leave of this court to file an untimely request for a bill of exceptions is ordered to show cause, within 7 days of this order, why the appeal should not proceed as if no bill of exceptions had been requested.
