The amended decree included a different method for accounting for purported overpayments by appellant toward his alimony obligations, and also changed the amount of an equalization payment. The parties filed motions to alter or amend judgment within ten days of the March 31, 2026, amended decree but not within ten days of the March 27, 2026, decree.

Where an order or judgment is amended in a material and substantial respect, the time for appeal runs from the date of the amendment. In re Interest of Luz P., 295 Neb. 814, 891 N.W.2d 651 (2017). However, "[w]here a later order or judgment modifies, vacates, amends, or contradicts a prior order or judgment, the time for appeal from that portion of the later order which contradicts the earlier order -and that portion only- runs from the issuance of the later order." Id. at 827-28, 891 N.W.2d at 661 citing Manske v. Manske, 246 Neb. 314, 518 N.W.2d 144 (1994) (emphasis in original).

The parties are directed to include in their briefs a discussion of their claimed jurisdictional basis for any issues they believe are preserved in this appeal in light of the procedural posture of the case.
