Nebraska Separate Juvenile Courts Annual Caseload Report

Fiscal Year 2019 — July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019

This Annual Separate Juvenile Court Caseload Report contains caseload statistics for Nebraska's three Separate Juvenile Courts. Statistics are compiled through extracts from the JUSTICE automated trial court case management system. Providing court statistics ensures transparency to the public and assists administration in ensuring efficient court practices.

Caseload data is now produced with a new, more reliable reporting software tool. Prior to FY 2016, caseload data was extracted and aggregated monthly through a programmed process. The 10 year history section of this Caseload Report should not be compared to reports prior to FY 2016.

Caseload statistics demonstrate the volume of cases in each jurisdiction and the changes that occur over time. Data are useful in determining staffing levels and for predicting the effect on caseloads due to changes in the law.


Mission of the Nebraska Administrative Office of the Courts:





Lancaster County had 336 Juvenile 3A cases opened which involved 620 children.




