On October 22, 2025, the Nebraska Supreme Court adopted the following rule amendments to Neb. Ct. R. § 6-1208:

CHAPTER 6: TRIAL COURTS

. . . .

Article 12: Problem-Solving Courts.

. . . .

§ 6-1208. Operational requirements.

. . . .

(I) Problem solving courts in which Where a problem-solving court relies upon the collection of state or local fees applies shall not deny entrance from program participants, nor terminate from the program based on an individual's inability to pay such fees shall not be used to deny entrance to or advancement within the program, or as a reason for termination from the program. Decisions regarding the inability to pay fees are subject to judicial discretion.
